Camp selection of participants will be based on the ability to follow these guidelines:

- Drop off and pick up will be at the front door of the Pythian building.
- Parents/Guardians must stay outside the building during this process.
- Must wash hands or use hand sanitizer upon entering the building.
- Each participant will have an assigned area to sit at during activities and lunch.
- Must bring ready to eat lunch.
- Must be able to maintain social distancing.
- **Must be able to wear a mask.** Requirements for masking will depend on current Arc policies and CDC guidelines.
- Must be able to transition with a group and attend all outings.
